November – December Recap

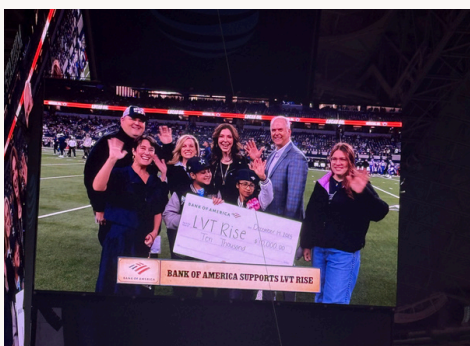
