July Recap

July was everything we could've hoped for—and more! Our on-site programming kept the center buzzing with energy all summer long. We partnered with Girls Inc. to host a weeklong program for 25 girls, focusing on team building, women in STEM, future readiness, and discovering their talents and passions. The week was filled with games, hands-on science activities, teamwork challenges, self-reflection, financial literacy, and career exploration—all while building friendships and having fun together.

We also welcomed Texas Ballet Theater School, who introduced 12 children to the beauty of ballet through an engaging program right here at the center. In addition, KERA joined us on Tuesdays during our weekly food pantry—the busiest time of our week. Over the course of the month, 42 children and their parents participated in interactive workshops, enjoying literacy activities, crafts, and meaningful time together as families.

Beyond youth programming, our monthly Apartment Manager Meeting brought together 27 participants, including local property managers and neighborhood police officers, to strengthen communication and collaboration. And one bright Saturday morning, 12 community members joined us for Walk with a Doc, promoting health and connection.

As you can see, July was full of activity and impact. None of this would be possible without our incredible partners, volunteers, and staff who bring our mission to life each day. Together We Rise!

Let's Hit the Goal Together!


